But is Sheetz really worth all of the hype it is getting? To figure this out, we decided to take a trip to Sheetz and find out for ourselves.

We bought four items at Sheetz. A blue raspberry slushie, french fries, chicken tenders, and mozzerella sticks. The first thing we bought was a blue raspberry slushie. The cost of the slushie added up to be \$3.44. To us, this price wasn't too unreasonable since we purchased one of the medium sizes. However, you can definitely find a slushie for a more manageable price at other places. With all honesty, the slushie was very sweet and rich in flavor, which some people may like, but it was a bit much for us.

French fries are one of the most

common orders placed at Sheetz. You can get a variety of different sizes either in a small paper bag or a plastic cup. We got the medium size in a cup. Unfortunately, the fries were a bit pricey compared to other places, costing \$3.39. After tasting the fries, we concluded that they tasted very flavorful, considering that they weren't soft and thick fries.

Unfortunately, the chicken tenders were the most expensive item that we ordered and our least favorite as well. The cost added up to \$7.79 which was costly for chicken tenders. The chicken tenders were dipped in buffalo sauce, which made them taste different when we tried them. They did not live up to the average chicken tender taste.

New appetizers have also recenty come to Sheetz including their mozzarella sticks. You can buy mozzarella sticks in different quantities and can choose what sauce you want when ordering. This appetizer cost us \$4.39,
