# Munching On Menchies

With summer coming up, you might find yourself looking for a sweet treat to cool off with. If this is the case, you should try Menchies Frozen Yogurt on Sawmill Road. Menchies has a make-your-own frozen yogurt collection where you can put as much froyo as you want with a large variety of toppings. It is the perfect place to go for a quick hangout in the summer. Ali Amelung and I took a trip to Menchies for our journalism class because we each hadn't been there in a while and wanted to renew our opinions on their froyo. For this review, I am going to review what we got during our trip to Menchies and some recommendations for when you decide to go.

To start, you have three choices for your cup size: small (6 oz.), medium (10 oz.), and large
(14 oz.). We each chose small for the size and would say that it was a good portion size. You also will have a lot of different choices for flavors of froyo, these will vary depending on which store you go to. When you pick your flavor, for example, vanilla, chocolate, strawberry, etc, there is an option where you can combine and swirl with the flavors that share the same station. Most of them go well together in our opinion, except banana pudding and chocolate didn't swirl well. Then, you get to pull your own lever and swirl the froyo in whichever way you decide. Each of us got cake batter but Ali decided to also do strawberry as well.

For the toppings, there is something for everyone, you will likely be choosing something. There are all types of candy including $\mathrm{M} \& \mathrm{Ms}$, Oreos, Nilla wafers, animal

crackers, cereal, a selection of fruit, syrups, boba, and more. For my toppings, I got Fruity Pebbles, gummy worms, and graham cracker crust. It seems like a weird mix but you shouldn't judge it until you try it. However, the gummy worms were pretty disappointing because I forgot how hard they get as soon as they hit the froyo. So, if you are similar to me and don't like hard, chewy textures, I wouldn't recommend it. Ali also got fruity pebble toppings, then $\mathrm{M} \& \mathrm{Ms}$, and marshmallow cream. She says she liked everything but the marshmallow cream because the taste and texture didn't blend with everything else.

So next time you go to Menchies, think of this review and take note of the things we warned about. Or you might feel confident about some of the misses in our opinion and try it yourself. However, I have to add that I think it would be a safe bet to add some fruity pebbles to your bowl with cake batter froyo since we both liked it and it's definitely worth a try, coming from big froyo fans.
