

# What is the Hype About Stanley Cups??

As many know, the new popular Stanley Cup Tumbler has become a trendy accessory over this year. They vary in size, color, price, etc., but what's all the hype really about?

To begin with, sizing of the tumbler, the average size for a Stanley cup is 30 oz. cup or 887 ml. On the other hand they do carry different sizes as well, varying from 14 oz. to 40 oz. The 30 oz. and 40 oz. cup comes with a large durable handle to carry the cup easily and comfortably. Unfortunately the 14 and 20 oz. cups don't come with a handle but it is still made to be easily transported and comfortable to effortlessly carry with you.

Another aspect of the cup that many wonder about is the variation in colors you are able to purchase these cups in. In the 40 oz. and 30 oz. cups you have an option of Soft Matte or just the original style cup but this option is only available in those two sizes. Colors vary between the sizes and in the 40 oz cup there are much more options to pick from than the other sizes. The most natural and common color cups are Dune, Stormy Sea, Shale, Red Rust, and Bay Leaf. 40 oz. cups come in plenty more color variations compared to the other cups.

Next is the prices of these tumblers. To start off with the 40 oz. cup is \$45 in the original style cup and \$50 in the Soft Matte style. Secondly, 30 oz. Soft Matte style cup is \$40. Lastly, the 20 oz cup is priced at \$30 and the 14 oz cup is priced at \$20. These prices are another high aspect as to why they are so trendy at the moment.

While there are a lot of pros to the popular

tumblr there are also cons. One con is the cups leak, many have noticed that when the cups fall or tip over they spill a lot of water out of the hole the straw goes into. There have been inserts made to put into the cup to prevent all the water from dumping everywhere when/if they get knocked over. Another con of these cups is how heavy they are to carry around while 40 or 30 ounces of water can become heavy for someone to lug around with them. Those are two of the most popular cons mentions about these trend rising tumblers.

In conclusion, while there are cons to everything, in this case the pros of the Stanley water bottles outweigh the cons. The popularity of these cups will continue to grow and gain attention for their reasonable sizing, eye grabbing colors, and affordable pricing.
