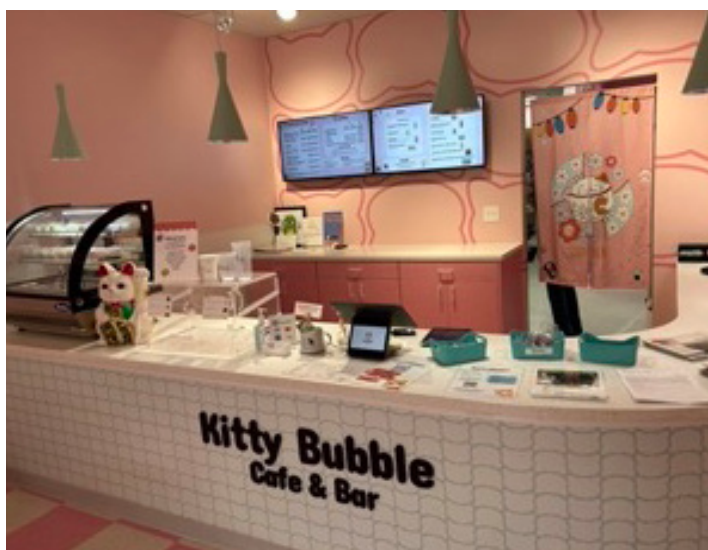


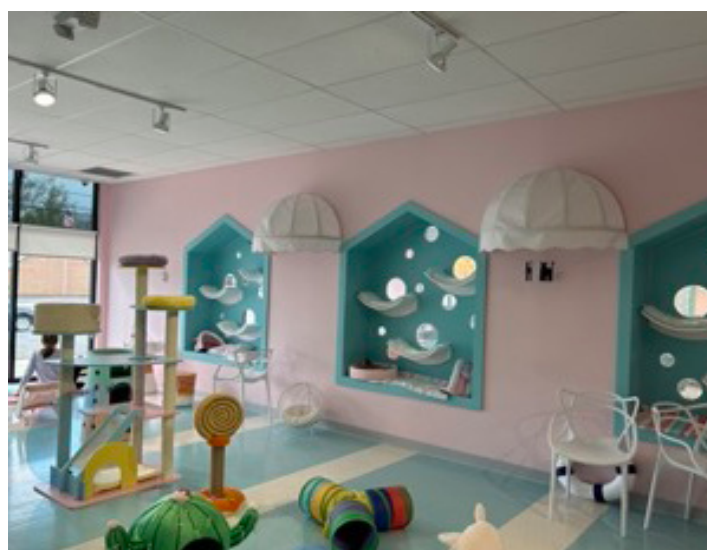
# Kitty Bubble Cafe & Bar

## The Purr-fect Place to Relax and Unwind

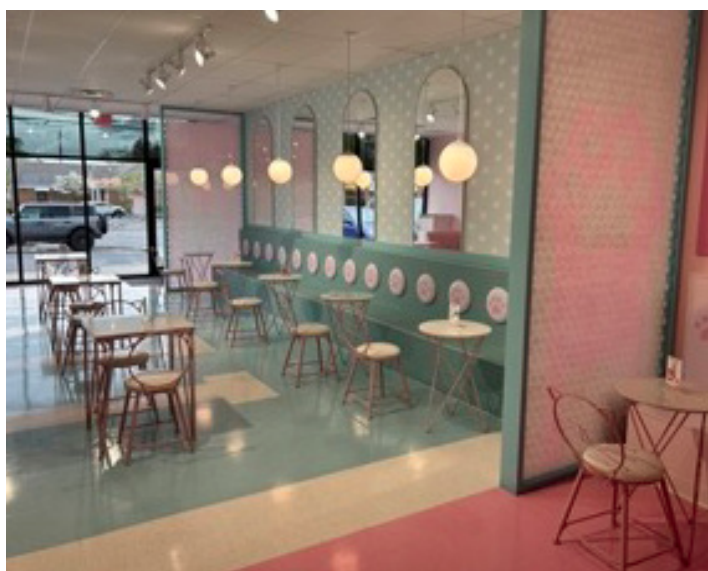

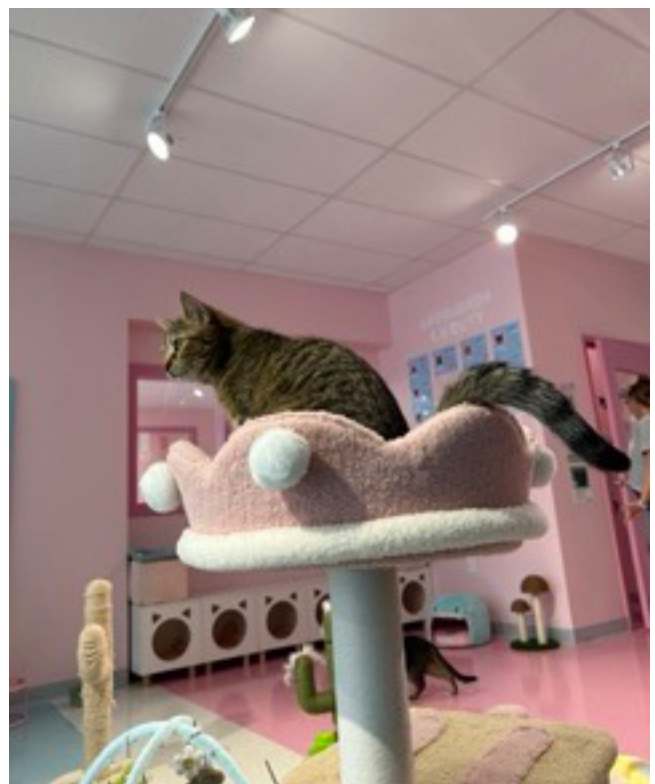
