put into it is amazing.

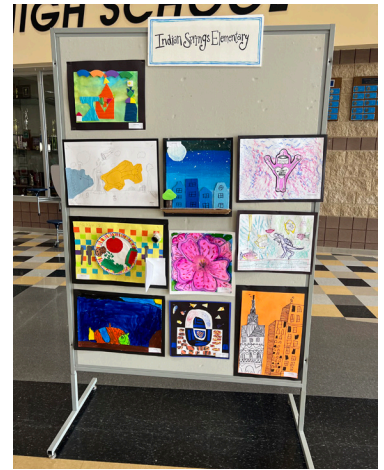




There are four elementary schools in olentangy, Scioto ridge, Tyler run, Liberty tree, and Indian springs elementary schools. These pieces of art show lots of colors
