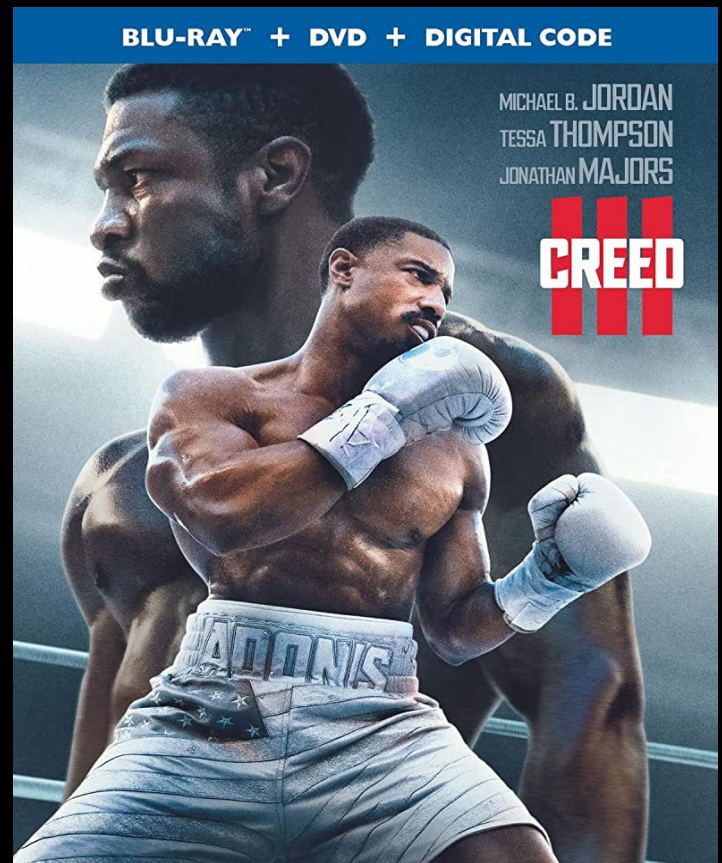
Last month, the new Creed movie, “Creed III” was released. This was a great addition to the previous movies before and helped carry on the storyline that was created throughout the last two movies.
