Upon receiving the quesadilla, the first thing I judged was the size of it. The size was a perfect size, it wasn't too big or too small. It also didn't have a lot of grease. Often at many restaurants the quesadillas are way too greasy but this one surprisingly had no grease. When I first picked it up, it did not leave any grease on my hand and was the perfect texture.

The next thing to test was the amount of cheese in the quesadilla. It had the perfect amount of cheese and was

perfectly melted inside. The cheese wasn't oozing out and it also didn't just taste like bread it was perfect. The next thing to test was the taste.
