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Exams are extremely important as they count for 20% of the student's semester course average and therefore can significantly affect the semester grade. Students are expected to take their exams during the regularly scheduled time.

1. Exam days are considered days of attendance to school and students are expected to attend during the date and time of their scheduled exams. Attendance will be collected during each exam period.

2. Students do not need to arrive at school until their first scheduled exam period of the day. Notes are not required for students who are arriving for a late exam. In order to keep hallway noise to a minimum, students are expected to wait in the Commons until an exam dismissal bell.

3. Students are NOT permitted to leave school in between exams. For example, students are not permitted to attend the first exam period, leave during the middle exam period, and return for the final exam period. Supervised study halls will be provided for students in this circumstance. Leaving school during this time is considered truancy and will result in disciplinary action.

4. The make-up time for a student who misses an exam is Friday December 20th from 11:20 a.m. to 12:50 p.m. If more than one exam needs to be rescheduled, it is the student's responsibility to arrange a time with their teacher to complete the exam.

5. The dismissal time on Friday for all students who have completed all their exams will be 10:30 a.m. Only those students needing to complete a make-up exam are required to remain at school. Students and parents should arrange transportation accordingly on this day.

6. Bus transportation will run as regularly scheduled (this includes Tuesday of exam week). Students arriving late or leaving early must arrange their own transportation to and from school.

7. Breakfast and lunch will be served on exam days.

8. Exams are only to be moved with administrative approval. We will try and help any student "balance" their exam schedule (if they need it); however, we are not going to be approving exam schedule changes so that students can go on an ALE/vacation.

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SENIOR FINAL EXAM EXEMPTIONS

The purpose of providing an exemption for seniors is to give another incentive to work through the end of the year while giving students a reward for the hard work they have put in during their school career. This exemption applies ONLY to the second semester exams and can change at any time through the course of the school year.

Courses affected: English, Science, Math, World Language, Government *Seniors*

may be exempt from their second semester exam in the courses above if:

1. They are taking an AP course or OST in that area (the AP exam/OST will take the place of the semester exam).
2. If a student scores a B- or above on the FIRST semester exam, that student may be exempt from the second semester exam in that course.
3. If the student achieves an A from the beginning of the third nine weeks through the interim report of the fourth nine weeks. This is NOT an A average between the two, but an A for the third nine weeks grade AND an A for the fourth nine weeks interim report.
